Mrs. FEINSTEIN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Benjamin Cabrera-Gomez and Londy Patricia Cabrera.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR BEN-**
4 **JAMIN CABRERA-GOMEZ AND LONDY PATRI-**
5 **CIA CABRERA.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
7 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
8 Act, Benjamin Cabrera-Gomez and Londy Patricia
9 Cabrera shall be eligible for the issuance of immigrant
10 visas or for adjustment of status to that of aliens lawfully
11 admitted for permanent residence upon filing an applica-

1 tion for issuance of immigrant visas under section 204 of
2 that Act or for adjustment of status to lawful permanent
3 resident.

4 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Benjamin
5 Cabrera-Gomez and Londy Patricia Cabrera enter the
6 United States before the filing deadline specified in sub-
7 section (c), Benjamin Cabrera-Gomez and Londy Patricia
8 Cabrera shall be considered to have entered and remained
9 lawfully and shall be eligible for adjustment of status
10 under section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act
11 as of the date of enactment of this Act.

12 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
13 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
14 plication for issuance of immigrant visas or the application
15 for adjustment of status are filed with appropriate fees
16 within 2 years after the date of enactment of this Act.

17 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBERS.—
18 Upon the granting of immigrant visas or permanent resi-
19 dence to Benjamin Cabrera-Gomez and Londy Patricia
20 Cabrera, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper
21 officer to reduce by 2, during the current or next following
22 fiscal year, the total number of immigrant visas that are
23 made available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth
24 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
25 Act or, if applicable, the total number of immigrant visas

1 that are made available to natives of the country of the
2 aliens' birth under section 202(e) of that Act.
