A BILL

To reinstate the safeguard measures imposed on imports of certain steel products, as in effect on December 4, 2003.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REINSTATEMENT OF SAFEGUARD MEASURES**

4 **ON CERTAIN STEEL PRODUCTS.**

5 Notwithstanding the proclamation of the President of
6 the United States of December 4, 2003—

7 (1) those safeguard measures implemented
8 under Proclamation 7529 of March 5, 2002, with re-
9 spect to certain steel products, including the modi-
10 fications made by Proclamation 7529 to subchapter

1 III of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule
2 of the United States, shall remain in effect during
3 the period beginning on December 5, 2003, and end-
4 ing on the applicable date provided in subchapter III
5 of chapter 99 of such Schedule, as in effect on De-
6 cember 4, 2003; and

7 (2) the proclamation of the President of Decem-
8 ber 4, 2003, and the modifications to the Har-
9 monized Tariff Schedule made by that proclamation,
10 shall have no effect.
