To convert certain temporary Federal district judgeships to permanent judgeships, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONVERSION OF TEMPORARY JUDGESHIPS TO**
4 **PERMANENT JUDGESHIPS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The existing judgeships for the
6 eastern district of California, the district of Hawaii, the
7 district of Kansas, the eastern district of Missouri, and
8 the district of Nebraska authorized by section 203(c) of
9 the Judicial Improvements Act of 1990 (Public Law 101–
10 650, 104 Stat. 5089) as amended by Public Law 105–

1 53, as of the date of enactment of this Act, shall be au-
 2 thorized under section 133 of title 28, United States Code,
 3 and the incumbents in those offices shall hold the office
 4 under section 133 of title 28, United States Code, as
 5 amended by this Act.

6 (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—
 7 The table contained in section 133(a) of title 28, United
 8 States Code, is amended by—

9 (1) striking the item relating to California and
 10 insert the following:
