- 3 SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.
- 4 The Federal building located at Fifth and Richardson
- 5 Avenues in Roswell, New Mexico, shall be known and des-
- 6 ignated as the "Joe Skeen Federal Building".
- 7 SEC. 2. REFERENCES.
- 8 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
- 9 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal

- 1 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
- 2 a reference to the Joe Skeen Federal Building.
- 3 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 4 This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2005.
