## **AN ACT**

For the relief of Alemseghed Mussie Tesfamical.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## 1 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for purposes of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.), Alemseghed Mussie Tesfamical shall be held and considered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent residence as of the date of enactment of this Act upon payment of the required visa fees.

## 9 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.

10 Upon the granting of permanent residence to 11 Alemseghed Mussie Tesfamical, the Secretary of State 12 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1, during the 13 current fiscal year, the total number of immigrant visas 14 available to natives of the country of the alien's birth 15 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality 16 Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
