- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. AUTHORITY OF LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OF-
- 4 FICERS TO CARRY FIREARMS ON AIRCRAFT.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after the
- 6 date of the enactment of this Act, the Under Secretary
- 7 of Transportation for Security shall prescribe regulations
- 8 that permit qualified local law enforcement officers to
- 9 carry accessible weapons while onboard an aircraft to the
- 10 same extent and subject to the same limits as Federal law
- 11 enforcement officers are permitted pursuant to section

1	1544.219 of title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, or any
2	successor regulation.
3	(b) Qualified Local Law Enforcement Offi-
4	CER.—In this section, the term "qualified local law en-
5	forcement officer" means any full-time municipal, county,
6	or State law enforcement officer, whether or not on official
7	travel, who—
8	(1) is a direct employee of a government agency
9	that—
10	(A) employs more than 400 employees; and
11	(B) is accredited by a nationally recognized
12	law enforcement accreditation program;
13	(2) is armed in accordance with an agency-wide
14	policy established by the employing agency by direc-
15	tive or policy statement; and
16	(3) otherwise complies with the requirements
17	relating to Federal law enforcement officers.
