Mr. DORGAN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred
to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Klaus Dieter Hinze, Heidi Hinze,
Annamarie Hinze, and Roberto Arndt.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR KLAUS DI-**

4 **ETER HINZE, HEIDI HINZE, ANNAMARIE**

5 **HINZE, AND ROBERTO ARNDT.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
7 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
8 Act, Klaus Dieter Hinze, Heidi Hinze, Annamarie Hinze,
9 and Roberto Arndt shall each be eligible for issuance of
10 an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status to that of

1 an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence upon
2 filing an application for issuance of an immigrant visa
3 under section 204 of such Act or for adjustment of status
4 to lawful permanent resident.

5 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Klaus Dieter
6 Hinze, Heidi Hinze, Annamarie Hinze, and Roberto Arndt
7 enter the United States before the filing deadline specified
8 in subsection (c), Klaus Dieter Hinze, Heidi Hinze,
9 Annamarie Hinze, and Roberto Arndt shall be considered
10 to have entered and remained lawfully and shall, if other-
11 wise eligible, be eligible for adjustment of status under
12 section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act as of
13 the date of enactment of this Act.

14 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
15 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
16 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-
17 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees
18 within 2 years after the date of enactment of this Act.

19 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—
20 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-
21 idence to Klaus Dieter Hinze, Heidi Hinze, Annamarie
22 Hinze, and Roberto Arndt the Secretary of State shall in-
23 struct the proper officer to reduce by 4, during the current
24 or next following fiscal year, the total number of immi-
25 grant visas that are made available to natives of the coun-

1 try of the aliens' birth under section 203(a) of the Immi-
2 gration and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the total
3 number of immigrant visas that are made available to na-
4 tives of the country of the aliens' birth under section
5 202(e) of such Act.
