3 **SECTION 1. ELECTRON GUNS FOR CATHODE RAY TUBES**
4 **FOR HIGH DEFINITION TELEVISIONS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.85.25	Electron guns actually used for cathode ray tubes (CRT's) for high definition televisions with a high definition television screen aspect ratio of 16:9 (provided for in subheading 8540.91.50)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2006	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
2 this section applies with respect to goods entered, or with-
3 drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after the
