- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Assault Weapons Ban
- 5 Reauthorization Act of 2004".
- 6 SEC. 2. 10-YEAR EXTENSION OF ASSAULT WEAPONS BAN.
- 7 Section 110105 of the Public Safety and Recreational
- 8 Firearms Use Protection Act (18 U.S.C. 921 note) is
- 9 amended to read as follows:

1 "SEC. 110105. SUNSET PROVISION.

- 2 "This subtitle and the amendments made by this sub-
- 3 title are repealed September 13, 2014.".
