- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Stopping Overseas
- 5 Subsidies Act of 2004".
- 6 SEC. 2. APPLICATION OF COUNTERVAILING DUTIES TO
- 7 NONMARKET ECONOMY COUNTRIES.
- 8 Section 701(a)(1) of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19
- 9 U.S.C. 1671(a)(1)) is amended by inserting "(including

- 1 a nonmarket economy country)" after "country" each
- 2 place it appears.
- 3 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 4 The amendments made by section 2 apply to petitions
- 5 filed under section 702 of the Tariff Act of 1930 on or
- 6 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
