1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “New Shipper Review
5 Amendment Act of 2004”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF NEW SHIPPER BONDING PRIVILEGES.**

7 Section 751(a)(2)(B) of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19
8 U.S.C. 1675(a)(2)(B)) is amended—

9 (1) by striking clause (iii); and

1 (2) by redesignating clause (iv) as clause (iii).
