A BILL

To modify the boundary of the Harry S Truman National Historic Site in the State of Missouri, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Truman Farm Home
- 5 Expansion Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. HARRY S TRUMAN NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE
- 7 BOUNDARY MODIFICATION.
- 8 The first section of Public Law 98–32 (16 U.S.C.
- 9 461 note) is amended—

- 1 (1) by redesignating subsection (d) as sub-2 section (e); and 3 (2) by inserting after subsection (c) the fol-4 lowing: 5 "(d) Acquisition of Additional Land.— 6 "(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary may acquire, 7 by donation, purchase with donated or appropriated 8 funds, transfer from another Federal agency, or any 9 other means, the land described in paragraph (2) for 10 inclusion in the Harry S Truman National Historic 11 Site. 12 "(2) Description of Land.—The land re-13 ferred to in paragraph (1) consists of the approxi-
- mately 5 acres of land (including the structure located south of the Truman Farm Home site), as generally depicted on the map entitled 'Harry S Truman National Historic Site Proposed Boundary', numbered 80,027, and dated April 17, 2003.
 - "(3) Boundary Modification.—On acquisition of the land under this subsection, the Secretary shall modify the boundary of the Harry S Truman National Historic Site to reflect the acquisition of the land.".
