To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 73 South Euclid Avenue in Montauk, New York, as the “Perry B. Duryea, Jr. Post Office”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERRY B. DURYEYEA, JR. POST OFFICE.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
5 Postal Service located at 73 South Euclid Avenue in

1 Montauk, New York, shall be known and designated as  
2 the “Perry B. Duryea, Jr. Post Office”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
6 be deemed to be a reference to the Perry B. Duryea, Jr.  
7 Post Office.
