## A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, to allow additional transit systems greater flexibility with certain mass transportation projects.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Transit System Flexi-  
5 bility Protection Act of 2004”.

6 **SEC. 2. GENERAL AUTHORITY.**

7 Section 5307(b)(1) of title 49, United States Code,  
8 is amended by adding at the end the following:

1        “The Secretary may make grants under this section  
2 to a transit system to finance the operating cost of equip-  
3 ment and facilities for use in mass transportation in an  
4 urbanized area with a population of more than 200,000  
5 if such transit system operates less than 100 buses on  
6 fixed route service during peak service hours.”.
