4 This Act may be cited as the "Medicare Preventive

5 Services Coverage Act of 2004".

- 9 (a) COVERAGE.—

6 prevention or early detection of an illness or disability.

7 "(2) In making determinations under paragraph (1),
8 the Secretary shall—

9 "(A) take into account evidence-based rec10 ommendations by the United States Preventive Serv11 ices Task Force and other appropriate organizations;

"(B) use the process for making national coverage determinations (as defined in section
1869(f)(1)(B)) under this title.".
