AN ACT

To adjust the boundary of Redwood National Park in the
State of California.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Redwood National
5 Park Boundary Adjustment Act of 2004”.

1 **SEC. 2. REDWOOD NATIONAL PARK BOUNDARY ADJUST-**
2 **MENT.**

3 Section 2(a) of the Act of Public Law 90–545 (16
4 U.S.C. 79b(a)) is amended—

5 (1) in the first sentence, by striking “(a) The
6 area” and all that follows through the period at the
7 end and inserting the following: “(a)(1) The Red-
8 wood National Park consists of the land generally
9 depicted on the map entitled ‘Redwood National
10 Park, Revised Boundary’, numbered 167/60502, and
11 dated February, 2003.”;

12 (2) by inserting after paragraph (1) (as des-
13 ignated by paragraph (1)) the following:

14 “(2) The map referred to in paragraph (1) shall be—

15 “(A) on file and available for public inspection
16 in the appropriate offices of the National Park Serv-
17 ice; and

18 “(B) provided by the Secretary of the Interior
19 to the appropriate officers of Del Norte and Hum-
20 boldt Counties, California.”; and

21 (3) in the second sentence—

22 (A) by striking “The Secretary” and in-
23 serting the following:

24 “(3) The Secretary”; and

- 1 (B) by striking “one hundred and six thou-
2 sand acres” and inserting “133,000 acres”.
