1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Law Enforce-
3 ment Pension Adjustment Equity Act of 2004”.

4 **SEC. 2. PERMITTING ADJUSTMENTS IN PENSION BENEFITS**
5 **FOR UNITED STATES PARK POLICE AND**
6 **UNITED STATES SECRET SERVICE UNI-**
7 **FORMED DIVISION ANNUITANTS.**

8 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 905 of the Law Enforce-
9 ment Pay Equity Act of 2000 (sec. 5–561.02, D.C. Offi-
10 cial Code) is amended by striking subsection (f).

11 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
12 subsection (a) shall take effect as if included in the enact-
13 ment of the Law Enforcement Pay Equity Act of 2000.
