## A BILL

Making a supplemental appropriation for the Department of Education for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2004, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “No Child Left Behind  
5       Appropriations Support Act of 2004”.

6       **SEC. 2. SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION.**

7       (a) APPROPRIATION.—To carry out this Act, out of  
8       any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,  
9       there is appropriated \$237,000,000, to remain available

1 until expended, for the Department of Education for the  
2 fiscal year ending September 30, 2004.

3 (b) PAYMENTS.—In addition to amounts otherwise  
4 provided to a local educational agency under subpart 2  
5 of part A of title I of the Elementary and Secondary Edu-  
6 cation Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 6331 et seq.) for fiscal year  
7 2004, the Secretary of Education shall make a payment  
8 in an amount determined under subsection (c) to each  
9 local educational agency that receives a lesser amount of  
10 funds for fiscal year 2004 under such subpart than the  
11 agency received for fiscal year 2003.

12 (c) DETERMINATION OF AMOUNT.—The amount of  
13 a payment to a local educational agency under this Act  
14 shall be equal to the amount of the difference between—

15 (1) the amount the agency would otherwise re-  
16 ceive for fiscal year 2004 under subpart 2 of part  
17 A of title I of the Elementary and Secondary Edu-  
18 cation Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 6331 et seq.); and

19 (2) the amount the agency received for fiscal  
20 year 2003 under such subpart.

21 (d) DEFINITION.—In this Act, the term “local edu-  
22 cational agency” has the meaning given to that term in  
23 section 9101 of the Elementary and Secondary Education  
24 Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7801).
