1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF JUDGE WILLIAM B. BRYANT**
2 **ANNEX TO THE E. BARRETT PRETTYMAN FED-**
3 **ERAL BUILDING AND UNITED STATES COURT-**
4 **HOUSE.**

5 The annex to the E. Barrett Prettyman Federal
6 Building and United States Courthouse located at 333
7 Constitution Ave. Northwest in Washington, District of
8 Columbia, shall be known and designated as the “Judge
9 William B. Bryant Annex to the E. Barrett Prettyman
10 Federal Building and United States Courthouse”.

11 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

14 to the Federal building and United States Courthouse re-
15 ferred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
16 to the “Judge William B. Bryant Annex to the E. Barrett
17 Prettyman Federal Building and United States Court-
