AN ACT

For the relief of Griselda Lopez Negrete.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
3 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
4 1101 et seq.), Griselda Lopez Negrete shall be held and
5 considered to have been lawfully admitted to the United
6 States for permanent residence as of the date of enact-
7 ment of this Act upon payment of the required visa fees.

8 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

9 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Gri-
10 selda Lopez Negrete, as provided in section 1, the Sec-
11 retary of State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce
12 by the appropriate number during the current fiscal year
13 the total number of immigrant visas available to natives
14 of the country of the alien's birth under section 203(a)
15 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
16 1153(a)).
