A BILL

To amend titles V, XVIII, and XIX of the Social Security Act to promote cessation of tobacco use under the medicare program, the medicaid program, and the maternal and child health services block grant program.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Medicare, Medicaid,
- 5 and MCH Tobacco Cessation Promotion Act of 2004".

1	SEC. 2. MEDICARE COVERAGE OF COUNSELING FOR CES-
2	SATION OF TOBACCO USE.

18	'counseling for cessation of tobacco use' means diagnostic,

21	being treated for tobacco use which are furnished—
22	"(i) by or under the supervision of a physician;
23	"(ii) by a practitioner described in clause (i),
24	(iii), (iv), (v) or (vi) of section 1842(b)(18)(C); or
25	"(iii) by a licensed tobacco cessation counselor
26	(as defined in paragraph (2)).

1	"(B) Such term is limited to—
2	"(i) services recommended in 'Treating Tobacco
3	Use and Dependence: A Clinical Practice Guideline',
4	published by the Public Health Service in June
5	2000, or any subsequent modification of such Guide-
6	line; and
7	"(ii) such other services that the Secretary rec-
8	ognizes to be effective.

10	cessation counselor' means a tobacco cessation counselor

19	ing to basic knowledge, qualification training, con-
