A BILL

To provide competitive status to certain Federal employees
in the State of Alaska.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Thomas P. O’Hara
5 Public Land Career Opportunity Act of 2004”.

6 **SEC. 2. COMPETITIVE STATUS FOR CERTAIN FEDERAL EM-**
7 **PLOYEES IN THE STATE OF ALASKA.**

8 Section 1308 of the Alaska National Interest Lands
9 Conservation Act (16 U.S.C. 3198) is amended—

1 (1) by redesignating subsections (c) and (d) as
2 subsections (d) and (e); and

3 (2) by inserting after subsection (b) the fol-
4 lowing:

5 “(c) COMPETITIVE STATUS.—An individual ap-
6 pointed to a permanent position under subsection (a)
7 shall, after the completion of 1 year of service, be consid-
8 ered to have competitive status and shall enjoy the rights,
9 privileges, and benefits of employees holding competitive
10 status, including the rights, privileges, and benefits relat-
11 ing to promotion and transfer.”.
