 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Foundation for Ne-
 - 5 vada's Veterans Land Transfer Act of 2004".
 - 6 SEC. 2. TRANSFER OF ADMINISTRATIVE JURISDICTION.
 - 7 (a) In General.—Administrative jurisdiction over
 - 8 the land described in subsection (b) is transferred from

- 1 the Secretary of the Interior to the Secretary of Veterans
- 2 Affairs.
- 3 (b) Description of Land.—The parcel of land re-
- 4 ferred to in subsection (a) is the approximately 150 acres
- 5 of Bureau of Land Management land in Clark County,
- 6 Nevada, as generally depicted on the map entitled "Vet-
- 7 erans Administration Conveyance" and dated September
- 8 24, 2004.
- 9 (c) Use of Land.—The parcel of land described in
- 10 subsection (b) shall be used by the Secretary of Veterans
- 11 Affairs for the construction and operation of medical and
- 12 related facilities, as determined to be appropriate by the
- 13 Secretary of Veterans Affairs.
