A BILL

To require a report on the methodologies utilized for National Intelligence Estimates.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE COUNCIL REPORT
- 4 ON METHODOLOGIES UTILIZED FOR NA-
- 5 TIONAL INTELLIGENCE ESTIMATES.
- 6 (a) Report.—Not later than 180 days after the date
- 7 of the enactment of this Act, the National Intelligence
- 8 Council shall submit to Congress a report that includes
- 9 the following:

- 1 (1) The methodologies utilized for the initiation, 2 drafting, publication, coordination, and dissemina-3 tion of the results of National Intelligence Estimates 4 (NIEs).
- 5 (2) Such recommendations as the Council con-6 siders appropriate regarding improvements of the 7 methodologies utilized for National Intelligence Esti-8 mates in order to ensure the timeliness of such Esti-9 mates and ensure that such Estimates address the 10 national security and intelligence priorities and ob-11 jectives of the President and the Director of Central 12 Intelligence.
- 13 (b) FORM.—The report under subsection (a) shall be 14 submitted in an unclassified form, but may include a clas-15 sified annex.
