A BILL

To facilitate alternative analyses of intelligence by the
intelligence community.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ALTERNATIVE ANALYSES OF INTELLIGENCE BY**
4 **THE INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY.**

5 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con-
6 gress that the Director of Central Intelligence should con-
7 sider the advisability of establishing for each element of
8 the intelligence community an element, office, or compo-
9 nent whose purpose is the alternative analysis (commonly
10 referred to as a “red-team analysis”) of the information

1 and conclusions in the intelligence products of such ele-
2 ment of the intelligence community.

3 (b) REPORT.—(1) Not later than one year after the
4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of Central
5 Intelligence shall submit to Congress a report on the ac-
6 tions taken to establish for each element of the intelligence
7 community an element, office, or component described in
8 subsection (a).

9 (2) The report shall be submitted in an unclassified
10 form, but may include a classified annex.
