Mr. KENNEDY (for himself and Mr. KERRY) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To modify the boundary of Lowell National Historical Park, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Lowell National His-
5 torical Park Boundary Adjustment Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. LOWELL NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK.**

7 (a) BOUNDARY MODIFICATION.—Section 101(a) of
8 Public Law 95–290 (16 U.S.C. 410cc–11(a)) is amended
9 by adding at the end the following:

1 “(3) ADDITIONAL LAND.—The boundaries of
 2 the park are modified to include the 5 parcels of
 3 land identified on the map entitled ‘Boundary Ad-
 4 justment Lowell National Historical Park’, num-
 5 bered 475/81,424B, and dated September 2004, and
 6 more particularly described in section
 7 202(a)(2)(G).”.

8 (b) ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY.—Section 202(a) of
 9 Public Law 95–290 (16 U.S.C. 410cc–22(a)) is amended
 10 by adding at the end the following:

11 “(G) The following parcels of land, as
 12 identified on the map entitled ‘Boundary Ad-
 13 justment Lowell National Historical Park’,
 14 numbered 475/81,424B, and dated September
 15 2004:

16 “(i) 91 Pevey Street.

17 “(ii) The portion of 607 Middlesex
 18 Place.

19 “(iii) Eagle Court.

20 “(iv) The portion of 50 Payne Street.

21 “(v) 726 Broadway.”.
