A BILL

To support the Boy Scouts of America and the Girl Scouts of the United States of America.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SUPPORT OUR SCOUTS.
- 4 (a) Definition.—In this section the term "Federal
- 5 agency' means each department, agency, instrumentality,
- 6 or other entity of the United States Government.
- 7 (b) In General.—No Federal law (including any
- 8 rule, regulation, directive, instruction, or order) shall be
- 9 construed to limit any Federal agency from providing any
- 10 form of support to the Boy Scouts of America or the Girls

- Scouts of the United States of America (or any organization chartered by the Boy Scouts of America or the Girl
 Scouts of the United States of America), including—
- 4 (1) holding meetings, jamborees, camporees, or 5 other scouting activities on Federal property if such 6 organization has received permission from the appro-7 priate Federal official responsible for such property; 8 or
- 9 (2) hosting or sponsoring any official event of 10 such organization.
