## A BILL

To amend the September 11th Victim Compensation Fund of 2001 (49 U.S.C. 40101 note; Public Law 107–42) to provide compensation for victims killed in the bombing of the World Trade Center in 1993, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "World Trade Center
- 5 Bombing Victims Compensation Act of 2003".

### 8 SEC. 3. COMPENSATION FOR VICTIMS OF TERRORIST ACTS.

- 9 (a) Definitions.—Section 402(6) is amended by in-
- 10 serting "or related to the bombing of the World Trade
- 11 Center in 1993" before the period.
- 12 (b) Purpose.—Section 403 is amended by inserting
- 13 "or as a result of the bombing of the World Trade Center
- 14 in 1993" before the period.
- (c) Determination of Eligibility for Com-
- 16 PENSATION.—
- 17 (1) CLAIM FORM CONTENTS.—Section
- 405(a)(2)(B) is amended—
- (A) in clause (i), by inserting "or as a re-
- sult of the bombing of the World Trade Center
- in 1993" before the semicolon;
- (B) in clause (ii), by inserting "or bomb-
- 23 ing" before the semicolon; and
- (C) in clause (iii), by inserting "or bomb-
- ing" before the period.

1	(2) Limitation.—Section 405(a) is amended
2	by striking paragraph (3) and inserting the fol-
3	lowing:
4	"(3) Limitation.—
5	"(A) In general.—No claim may be filed
6	under paragraph (1) after the date that is 2
7	years after the date on which regulations are
8	promulgated under section 407.
9	"(B) Word trade center bombing
10	CLAIMS.—Notwithstanding subparagraph (A), a
11	claim may be filed under paragraph (1) relating
12	to the bombing of the World Trade Center in
13	1993 not later than 1 year after the date of en-
14	actment of the World Trade Center Bombing
15	Victims Compensation Act of 2003.".
16	(3) Collateral compensation.—Section
17	405(b)(6) is amended by inserting "or as a result of
18	the bombing of the World Trade Center in 1993"
19	before the period.
20	(4) Eligibility.—
21	(A) Individuals.—Section $405(c)(2)(A)$ is
22	amended—
23	(i) in clause (i), by inserting "or was
24	present at the World Trade Center in 1993

1	at the time of the bombing of the World
2	Trade Center" before the semicolon; and
3	(ii) by striking clause (ii) and insert-
4	ing the following:
5	"(ii) suffered physical harm or death
6	as a result of such an air crash or suffered
7	death as a result of such bombing;".
8	(B) Requirements.—Section 405(c)(3) is
9	amended—
10	(i) in the heading for subparagraph
11	(B) by inserting "RELATING TO SEP-
12	TEMBER 11TH TERRORIST ACTS" before the
13	period; and
14	(ii) by adding at the end the fol-
15	lowing:
16	"(C) Limitation on civil action relat-
17	ING TO THE BOMBING OF THE WORLD TRADE
18	CENTER IN 1993.—
19	"(i) In general.—Upon the submis-
20	sion of a claim under this title, the claim-
21	ant waives the right to file a civil action
22	(or to be a party to an action) in any Fed-
23	eral or State court for damages sustained
24	as a result of the bombing of the World
25	Trade Center in 1993. The preceding sen-

1	tence does not apply to a civil action to re-
2	cover any collateral source obligation based
3	on contract, or to a civil action against any
4	person who is a knowing participant in any
5	conspiracy to commit any terrorist act.
6	"(ii) Pending actions.—In the case
7	of an individual who is a party to a civil
8	action described in clause (i), such indi-
9	vidual may not submit a claim under this
10	title unless such individual withdraws from
11	such action by the date that is 90 days
12	after the date on which regulations are
13	promulgated under section 4 of the World
14	Trade Center Bombing Victims Compensa-
15	tion Act of 2003.
16	"(D) Individuals with Prior com-
17	PENSATION.—
18	"(i) In general.—Subject to clause
19	(ii), an individual is not an eligible indi-
20	vidual for purposes of this subsection if
21	that individual, or the estate of that indi-
22	vidual, has received any compensation from
23	a civil action or settlement based on tort
24	related to the bombing of the World Trade

Center in 1993.

1	"(ii) Exception.—Clause (i) shall
2	not apply to compensation received from a
3	civil action against any person who is a
4	knowing participant in any conspiracy to
5	commit any terrorist act.".
6	(C) Ineligibility of participants and
7	CONSPIRATORS.—Section 405(c) is amended by
8	adding at the end the following:
9	"(4) Ineligibility of participants and
10	CONSPIRATORS.—An individual, or a representative
11	of that individual, shall not be eligible to receive
12	compensation under this title if that individual is
13	identified by the Attorney General to have been a
14	participant or conspirator in the bombing of the
15	World Trade Center in 1993.".
16	SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.
17	Not later than 90 days after the date of enactment
18	of this Act, the Attorney General, in consultation with the
19	Special Master, shall promulgate regulations to carry out
20	the amendments made by this Act, including regulations
21	with respect to—
22	(1) forms to be used in submitting claims under
23	the amendments made by this Act;
24	(2) the information to be included in such
25	forms;

1	(3) procedures for hearing and the presentation
2	of evidence;
3	(4) procedures to assist an individual in filing
4	and pursuing claims under the amendments made by
5	this Act; and
6	(5) other matters determined appropriate by
7	the Attorney General.
