## A BILL

To authorize the project for hurricane and storm damage reduction, Morganza, Louisiana, to the Gulf of Mexico, Mississippi River and Tributaries.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. MORGANZA, LOUISIANA, TO THE GULF OF MEX-**  
4       **ICO, MISSISSIPPI RIVER AND TRIBUTARIES.**

5       The project for hurricane and storm damage reduc-  
6       tion, Morganza, Louisiana, to the Gulf of Mexico, Mis-  
7       sissippi River and Tributaries, is authorized to be carried  
8       out by the Secretary of the Army substantially in accord-  
9       ance with the plans, and subject to the conditions, de-

1 scribed in the Report of the Chief of Engineers dated Au-  
2 gust 23, 2002, at a total cost of \$680,000,000, with an  
3 estimated Federal cost of \$442,000,000 and an estimated  
4 non-Federal cost of \$238,000,000.
