 UNDER THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT.
 - (a) Civil Service Retirement System.—

- 1 (1) PAYMENTS.—Section 8345(e) of title 5, 2 United States Code, is amended in the first sentence 3 by inserting before the period ", or is a trustee 4 under a trust meeting the requirements of subpara-5 graph (A) or (C) of section 1917(d)(4) of the Social 6 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396p(d)(4) (A) or (C))".
 - (2) Assignability of Payments.—Section 8346(a) of title 5, United States Code, is amended by striking "except under" and inserting "except to a trust meeting the requirements of subparagraph (A) or (C) of section 1917(d)(4) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396p(d)(4) (A) or (C)) or under".
 - (b) Federal Employees Retirement System.—
 - (1) PAYMENTS.—Section 8466(c) of title 5, United States Code, is amended in the first sentence by inserting before the period ", or is a trustee under a trust meeting the requirements of subparagraph (A) or (C) of section 1917(d)(4) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396p(d)(4) (A) or (C))".
 - (2) Assignability of payments.—Section 8470(a) of title 5, United States Code, is amended by striking "except under" and inserting "except to a trust meeting the requirements of subparagraph (A) or (C) of section 1917(d)(4) of the Social Secu-
