A BILL

To provide for attempt liability for international parental
kidnapping.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION. 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “International Parental
5 Kidnapping Act of 2003”.

6 **SEC. 2. ATTEMPT LIABILITY FOR PARENTAL KIDNAPPING.**

7 Section 1204 of title 18, United States Code, is
8 amended—

9 (1) in subsection (a), by inserting “, or at-
10 tempts to do so,” before “or retains”; and

11 (2) in subsection (c)—

1 (A) in paragraph (1), by inserting “or the
2 Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction and En-
3 forcement Act” before “and was”; and

4 (B) in paragraph (2), by inserting “or”
5 after the semicolon.
