AN ACT

For the relief of Daniel King Cairo.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
3 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
4 1101 et seq.), Daniel King Cairo shall be held and consid-
5 ered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States
6 for permanent residence as of the date of enactment of
7 this Act upon payment of the required visa fees.

8 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

9 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Daniel
10 King Cairo, the Secretary of State shall instruct the prop-
11 er officer to reduce by the appropriate number during the
12 current fiscal year the total number of immigrant visas
13 available to natives of the country of the alien's birth
14 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
15 Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
