AN ACT

For the relief of Daniel King Cairo.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.

- 2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
- 3 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
- 4 1101 et seq.), Daniel King Cairo shall be held and consid-
- 5 ered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States
- 6 for permanent residence as of the date of enactment of
- 7 this Act upon payment of the required visa fees.

8 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.

- 9 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Daniel
- 10 King Cairo, the Secretary of State shall instruct the prop-
- 11 er officer to reduce by the appropriate number during the
- 12 current fiscal year the total number of immigrant visas
- 13 available to natives of the country of the alien's birth
- 14 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
- 15 Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
