## **JOINT RESOLUTION**

To repeal the seventeenth article of amendment to the Constitution of the United States.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled (two-
- 3 thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-
- 4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-
- 5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all
- 6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when
- 7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several
- 8 States within 7 years after the date of its submission for
- 9 ratification:

1	"ARTICLE —
2	"Section 1. The seventeenth article of amendment
3	to the Constitution of the United States is hereby re-
4	pealed.
5	"Section 2. The Senate of the United States shall
6	be composed of two Senators from each State, chosen by
7	the legislature thereof, for six years; and each Senator
8	shall have one vote.
9	"Section 3. If vacancies happen by resignation or
10	otherwise, during the recess of the legislature of any State
11	the executive thereof may make temporary appointments
12	until the next meeting of the legislature, which shall then
13	fill such vacancies.
14	"Section 4. This amendment shall not be so con-
