Mr. DODD submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the
Committee on Rules and Administration

RESOLUTION

To set standards for the naming of any part of the Senate
wing of the Capitol Building Complex.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. STANDARDS FOR NAMING PORTIONS OF THE**

3 **SENATE WING OF THE CAPITOL.**

4 (a) RESTRICTION.—The Senate shall not name any
5 portion of the Senate wing of the Capitol Building Com-
6 plex after any person unless not less than 5 years have
7 passed since the death of that person.

8 (b) DURATION.—

9 (1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided under
10 paragraph (2), the naming, by the Senate, of any

1 portion of the Senate wing of the Capitol Building
2 Complex shall remain in force for a period not to ex-
3 ceed 25 years beginning on the date of enactment of
4 the Act or resolution that established such name.

5 (2) EXISTING NAMED AREAS.—Any portion of
6 the Senate wing of the Capitol Building Complex
7 that is named as of the date of adoption of this reso-
8 lution shall no longer be so named after the date
9 that is 25 years after the date of adoption of this
10 resolution.

11 (c) DEFINITION.—In this resolution, the term “Sen-
12 ate wing of the Capitol Building Complex” includes—

13 (1) the Senate wing of the United States Cap-
14 itol Building;

15 (2) the Russell Senate Office Building;

16 (3) the Dirksen Senate Office Building;

17 (4) the Hart Senate Office Building; and

18 (5) spaces designated under the control of the
19 Senate in the Capitol Visitor Center.
