To authorize representation by the Senate Legal Counsel

Whereas the United States Senate Committee on the Judici-  
ary and Senator Orrin G. Hatch have been named as de-  
fendants in the case of Wagner v. United States Senate  
Committee on the Judiciary, et al., No. 1:03CV01225  
(RMU), pending in the United States District Court for  
the District of Columbia;

Whereas, pursuant to sections 703(a) and 704(a)(1) of the  
Ethics in Government Act of 1978, 2 U.S.C. §§ 288b(a)  
and 288c(a)(1), the Senate may direct its counsel to de-  
fend in civil actions Committees of the Senate, and Mem-  
bers of the Senate relating to the Members' official re-  
sponsibilities: Now, therefore, be it

3 the Judiciary and Senator Orrin G. Hatch in the case of
