RESOLUTION

To refer S. 279, entitled “A bill for the relief of the heirs of Clark M. Beggerly, Sr., of Jackson County, Mississippi” to the chief judge of the United States Court of Federal Claims for a report thereon.

1 *Resolved*, That—

2 (a) S. 279, entitled “A bill for the relief of the heirs
3 of Clark M. Beggerly, Sr., of Jackson County, Mis-
4 sissippi” now pending in the Senate, together with all the
5 accompanying papers, is referred to the chief judge of the
6 United States Court of Federal Claims; and

7 (b) the chief judge shall—

1 (1) proceed according to the provisions of sec-
2 tions 1492 and 2509 of title 28, United States Code;
3 and

4 (2) report back to the Senate, at the earliest
5 practicable date, providing—

6 (A) such findings of fact and conclusions
7 that are sufficient to inform Congress of the
8 nature, extent, and character of the claim for
9 compensation referred to in such bill as a legal
10 or equitable claim against the United States or
11 a gratuity; and

12 (B) the amount, if any, legally or equitably
13 due from the United States to the heirs of
14 Clark M. Beggerly, Sr., of Jackson County,
15 Mississippi.
