## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Congratulating the public schools of Westchester Public School District 92½ in Westchester, Illinois, on the occasion of the District's 75th anniversary, and for other purposes.

Whereas Westchester Public School District 92½ in Westchester, Illinois, was officially established in 1929 and can trace its origin to a pair of 2-room school houses constructed in that year in which 4 grades were taught in each room;

Whereas the public schools of Westchester Public School District 92½ overcame the early struggles of the Great Depression to reach their current size of 1 primary school (early childhood through second grade), 1 intermediate school (third through fifth grade), and 1 middle school

(sixth through eighth grade), together serving 1,120 students;

Whereas Westchester Public School District 92½ has successfully modernized such that each of its schools has a computer lab, a media center, and computers in every classroom;

Whereas approximately 80 teachers in Westchester Public School District 92½ nobly serve the community by providing positive educational experiences for all children;

Whereas the public schools of Westchester Public School District 92½ offer a rigorous curriculum of language arts, reading, social studies, mathematics, science, physical education, art, music, Spanish, and technology with the intent of developing lifelong learners who will become productive, responsible, and contributing members of the Nation's changing society with a continuing vision toward the future;

Whereas students in Westchester Public School District 92½ often receive recognition for excellence in technology, science, writing, public speaking, instrumental music, athletics, and community service; and

Whereas Westchester Public School District 92½ is celebrating its 75th anniversary during the 2004–2005 academic year: Now, therefore, be it
