Revising the concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year 2006.

Mr. GOODE (for himself, Mr. JONES of North Carolina, and Mr. GOHMERT) submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on the Budget

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Revising the concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year 2006.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That the concurrent resolution on the budget
3 for fiscal year 2006 (House Concurrent Resolution 95)
4 shall have force and effect as though it included the fol-
5 lowing modifications for fiscal year 2006:

6 (1) In paragraph (15) of section 103 (relating
7 to Veterans Benefits and Services (700)), the
8 amount of new budget authority shall be increased
9 by \$3,000,000,000 and the amount of outlays shall
10 be increased by \$3,000,000,000.

1 (2) In paragraph (2) of section 103 (relating to
2 International Affairs (150)), the amount of new
3 budget authority shall be reduced by \$5,000,000,000
4 and the amount of outlays shall be reduced by
5 \$5,000,000,000.
