## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-  
3 tive day of Friday, October 7, 2005, or Saturday, October  
4 8, 2005, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent  
5 resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand

1 adjourned until 2 p.m. on Monday, October 17, 2005, or  
2 until the time of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of  
3 this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and that  
4 when the Senate recesses or adjourns on Friday, October  
5 7, 2005, or Saturday, October 8, 2005, on a motion of-  
6 fered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Major-  
7 ity Leader or his designee, it stand recessed or adjourned  
8 until noon on Monday, October 17, 2005, or at such other  
9 time on that day as may be specified by its Majority Lead-  
10 er or his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or  
11 until the time of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of  
12 this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

13       SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority  
14 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting  
15 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the  
16 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify  
17 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,  
18 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-  
19 ignate if, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant  
20 it.
