Mr. THOMPSON of California submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on International Relations, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of Congress with respect to
accomplishing the mission in Iraq.

Whereas the members of the United States Armed Forces
have served honorably and courageously in Iraq;

Whereas Congress and the people of the United States owe
a debt of gratitude to those members of the Armed
Forces who have died fighting for their country; and

Whereas Iraq will have established a free and democratic gov-
ernment once it completes its constitution-making proc-
ess: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That it is the sense of Congress that—

1 (1) the United States should not maintain a
2 permanent military presence or military bases in
3 Iraq;

4 (2) the United States should not attempt to
5 control the flow of Iraqi oil; and

6 (3) United States Armed Forces should be re-
7 deployed from Iraq as soon as practicable after the
8 completion of Iraq's constitution-making process or
9 September 30, 2006, whichever occurs first.
