CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 **SECTION 1. EXHIBIT IN ROTUNDA OF THE CAPITOL IN**
2 **HONOR OF MEMBERS OF ARMED FORCES**
3 **KILLED IN IRAQ AND AFGHANISTAN.**

4 (a) ESTABLISHMENT OF TEMPORARY EXHIBIT.—
5 During the period beginning on May 29, 2006, and ending
6 on July 4, 2006, the Architect of the Capitol shall display
7 in the rotunda of the Capitol an exhibit to honor the mem-
8 ory of the members of the United States Armed Forces
9 who have lost their lives in Operation Iraqi Freedom and
10 Operation Enduring Freedom.

11 (b) FORM OF EXHIBIT.—The exhibit displayed under
12 this section shall be in such form and contain such mate-
13 rial as the Architect may select, so long as—

14 (1) the exhibit displays the name, photograph,
15 and biographical information with respect to each in-
16 dividual member of the United States Armed Forces
17 who has lost his or her life in the Operations re-
18 ferred to in subsection (a); and

19 (2) the exhibit provides an opportunity for visi-
20 tors to write messages of support and sympathy to
21 the families of the individuals represented in the ex-
22 hibit and provides a means to ensure that those mes-
23 sages are transmitted to the families.
