CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Thursday, June 29, 2006, or Friday, June 30,
4 2006, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent
5 resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand

1 adjourned until 2 p.m. on Monday, July 10, 2006, or until
2 the time of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this
3 concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and that
4 when the Senate recesses or adjourns on Thursday, June
5 29, 2006, Friday, June 30, 2006, or Saturday, July 1,
6 2006, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-
7 olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand
8 recessed or adjourned until noon on Monday, July 10,
9 2006, or such other time on that day as may be specified
10 by its Majority Leader or his designee in the motion to
11 recess or adjourn, or until the time of any reassembly pur-
12 suant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever
13 occurs first.

14 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
15 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
16 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
17 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
18 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
19 to reassemble at such place and time as they may

1 designate if, in their opinion, the public interest shall war-
2 rant it.
