## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an adjournment or recess of the two Houses.

1       *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2   *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-  
3   tive day of Thursday, July 27, 2006, or Friday, July 28,  
4   2006, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-  
5   olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand  
6   adjourned until 2 p.m. on Wednesday, September 6, 2006,  
7   or until the time of any reassembly pursuant to section  
8   2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and  
9   that when the Senate recesses or adjourns on Thursday,  
10   August 3, 2006, Friday, August 4, 2006, or Saturday, Au-  
11   gust 5, 2006, on a motion offered pursuant to this concur-  
12   rent resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it

1 stand recessed or adjourned until noon on Tuesday, Sep-  
2 tember 5, 2006, or such other time on that day as may  
3 be specified by its Majority Leader or his designee in the  
4 motion to recess or adjourn, or until the time of any re-  
5 assembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolu-  
6 tion, whichever occurs first.

7       SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority  
8 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting  
9 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the  
10 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify  
11 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,  
12 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-  
13 ignate if, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant  
14 it.
