## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an adjournment or recess of the two Houses.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-  
3 tive day of Thursday, February 17, 2005, on a motion  
4 offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Ma-  
5 jority Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned until 2

1 p.m. on Tuesday, March 1, 2005, or until the time of any  
2 reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolu-  
3 tion, whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate re-  
4 cesses or adjourns on Thursday, February 17, 2005, or  
5 Friday, February 18, 2005, on a motion offered pursuant  
6 to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his  
7 designee, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on  
8 Monday, February 28, 2005, or at such other time on that  
9 day as may be specified by its Majority Leader or his des-  
10 ignee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until the time  
11 of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent  
12 resolution, whichever occurs first.

13       SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority  
14 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting  
15 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the  
16 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify  
17 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,  
18 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-  
19 ignate whenever, in their opinion, the public interest shall  
20 warrant it.
