JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to ensure a free and adequate education for every child who is a citizen.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled
- 3 (two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-
- 4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-
- 5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all
- 6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when
- 7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several
- 8 States within seven years after the date of its submission
- 9 for ratification:

1 "ARTICLE—

- 2 "In order to more effectively promote the common defense,
- 3 provide for the general welfare, and establish a more per-
- 4 fect union; the right to a free and adequate education shall
- 5 be guaranteed to every child who is a citizen of the United
