JOINT RESOLUTION

Disapproving the issuance of letters of offer with respect to certain proposed sales of defense articles and defense services to Pakistan.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the issuance of a letter of offer with respect to any
4 of the following proposed sales to Pakistan (described in
5 the certifications transmitted to the Speaker of the House
6 of Representatives and the Chairman of the Committee
7 on Foreign Relations of the Senate pursuant to section
8 36(b) of the Arms Export Control Act on June 28, 2006)
9 is hereby prohibited:

1 (1) The proposed sale of defense articles and
2 defense services (Transmittal Number 06–09).

3 (2) The proposed sale of defense articles and
4 defense services (Transmittal Number 06–11).

5 (3) The proposed sale of defense articles and
6 defense services (Transmittal Number 06–34).
