Mr. CALVERT (for himself, Mr. LEWIS of California, and Mr. ISSA) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

## A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to participate in the design and construction of the Riverside-Corona Feeder in cooperation with the Western Municipal Water District of Riverside, California.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PLANNING, DESIGN, AND CONSTRUCTION OF**  
4       **THE RIVERSIDE-CORONA FEEDER.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Interior, in  
6       cooperation with the Western Municipal Water District,  
7       may participate in a project to plan, design, and construct  
8       a water supply project, the Riverside-Corona Feeder,

1 which includes 20 groundwater wells and 28 miles of pipe-  
2 line in San Bernardino and Riverside Counties, California.

3 (b) AGREEMENTS AND REGULATIONS.—The Sec-  
4 retary may enter into such agreements and promulgate  
5 such regulations as are necessary to carry out this section.

6 (c) FEDERAL COST SHARE.—

7 (1) PLANNING, DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION.—The  
8 Federal share of the cost to plan, design, and con-  
9 struct the project described in subsection (a) shall be  
10 the lesser of 35 percent of the total cost of the  
11 project or \$50,000,000.

12 (2) STUDIES.—The Federal share of the cost to  
13 complete the necessary planning study associated  
14 with the project described in subsection (a) shall not  
15 exceed 50 percent of the total study cost.

16 (d) IN-KIND SERVICES.—In-kind services performed  
17 by the Western Municipal Water District shall be consid-  
18 ered a part of the local cost share to complete the project  
19 described in subsection (a).

20 (e) LIMITATION.—Funds provided by the Secretary  
21 under this section shall not be used for operation or main-  
22 tenance of the project described in subsection (a).

23 **SEC. 2. PROJECT AUTHORIZATIONS.**

24 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Reclamation Wastewater and  
25 Groundwater Study and Facilities Act (Public Law 102–

1 575, title XVI; 43 U.S.C. 390h et seq.) is amended by  
2 adding at the end the following:

3 **“SEC. 163\_. YUCAIPA VALLEY REGIONAL WATER SUPPLY**  
4 **RENEWAL PROJECT.**

5 “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
6 tion with the Yucaipa Valley Water District, may partici-  
7 pate in the design, planning, and construction of projects  
8 to treat impaired surface water, reclaim and reuse im-  
9 paired groundwater, and provide brine disposal within the  
10 Santa Ana Watershed described in the report submitted  
11 under section 1606.

12 “(b) COST SHARING.—The Federal share of the cost  
13 of the project described in subsection (a) shall not exceed  
14 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

15 “(c) LIMITATION.—Funds provided by the Secretary  
16 shall not be used for operation or maintenance of the  
17 project described in subsection (a).

18 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
19 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
20 \$20,000,000.

21 **“SEC. 163\_. CITY OF CORONA WATER UTILITY, CALI-**  
22 **FORNIA, WATER RECYCLING AND REUSE**  
23 **PROJECT.**

24 “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
25 tion with the City of Corona Water Utility, California, is

1 authorized to participate in the design, planning, and con-  
2 struction of, and land acquisition for, a project to reclaim  
3 and reuse wastewater, including degraded groundwaters,  
4 within and outside of the service area of the City of Co-  
5 rona Water Utility, California.

6 “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
7 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
8 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

9 “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
10 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
11 authorized by this section.”.

12 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—The table of sec-  
13 tions in section 2 of Public Law 102–575 is amended by  
14 inserting after the item relating to section 163\_\_ the fol-  
15 lowing:

“Sec. 163\_\_. Yucaipa Valley Regional Water Supply Renewal Project.

“Sec. 163\_\_. City of Corona Water Utility, California, water recycling and reuse  
project.”.
