- 6 the appointment of additional district and circuit judges,
- 7 and for other purposes.", approved October 20, 1978
- 8 (Public Law 95–486; 28 U.S.C. 41 note), is amended by
- 9 striking "may perform its en banc function" and inserting

- 1 "may, except in the case of the Court of Appeals for the
- 2 Ninth Circuit, perform its en banc function".
