A BILL

To prohibit United States assistance for the Palestinian Authority and for programs, projects, and activities in the West Bank and Gaza, unless certain conditions are met.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON UNITED STATES ASSISTANCE
- 4 FOR THE PALESTINIAN AUTHORITY AND THE
- 5 WEST BANK AND GAZA.
- 6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, United
- 7 States assistance may not be provided directly or indi-
- 8 rectly to the Palestinian Authority (or to any successor

1	or related entity) or for programs, projects, and activities
2	in the West Bank or Gaza unless the President determines
3	and certifies to the Committee on International Relations
4	of the House of Representatives and the Committee on
5	Foreign Relations of the Senate that—
6	(1) the leadership of the Palestinian Author-
7	ity—
8	(A) is not tainted by violence;
9	(B) has publicly rebuked Palestinian vio-
10	lence and terror;
11	(C) has ended hateful incitement; and
12	(D) has taken all actions within its capac-
13	ity to dismantle the infrastructure of terrorism;
14	and
15	(2) the violence in the West Bank and Gaza has
16	subsided.
